- Improve teacher capabilities, through professional development and focused observation and feedback, to achieve improved student outcomes.
- Support students and provide intervention for students in all year levels who are evidently at risk of failing to achieve NMS and DDSW Regional Benchmarks in years to come.
- Whole school implementation of the 'Big 6 of Reading' focusing on 'Comprehension and Vocabulary'.

## **Our initiatives include**

- Use of short cycle data collection cycle to scan and assess student learning, prioritise areas for improvement, develop and plan teaching and learning required for improvement, provide focused instruction for improvement and review teaching and learning. Prep-Year 3 five-week cycle. Year 4-6 ten-week cycle.
- Continue to embed the culture, climate, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support professional development and encourage reflective practice/action learning.
- Further build teacher capability in consistently using 'The 16 elements of explicit instruction' and participation in "Leading Learning Collaborative Practice" initiative (Putting Faces on the Data) by all teaching staff.
- Continuing to develop and embed student learning goals focused on the Explicit Improvement Agenda of 'Reading Comprehension and Vocabulary'.
